Third graders will express text, rhythm, melody and harmony through the use of unpitched and pitched percussion instruments (Orff instruments), movements, handchimes and recorders. Musical skills will be developed verbally in speech play and vocally with beautiful singing. Third graders must be active members of the Wesley Singers.

All Chapel Bells ringers going on choir tour must also participate with Celebration Singers.

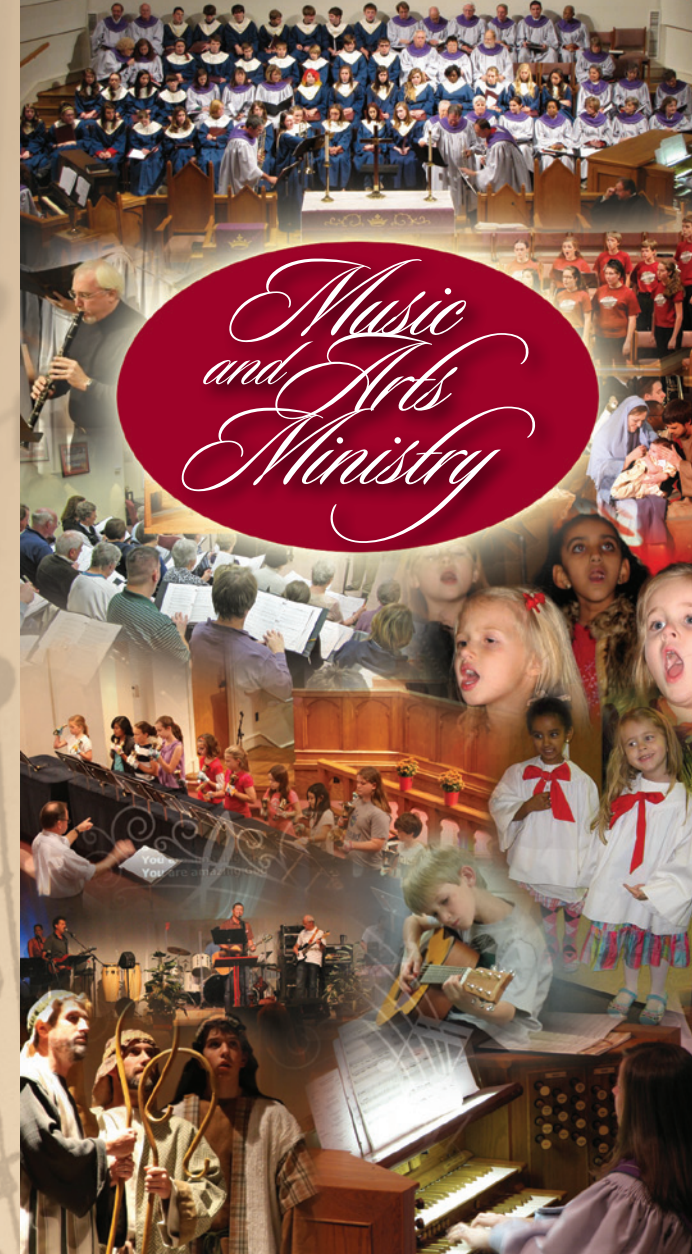
